A Comprehensive, Back to School Assistance Program

Project overview (Objectives)

AUDAV is a Cameroon based Non-Profit Organization, with objectives to:

- support Professional and Academic based initiatives for girls in desperate need,
- Motivate young girls who are bound to live and study in Manyu Division amidst the Socio-economic and political challenges caused by the ongoing crises,
- Support them through coaching and mentoring programs,
- provide sustainable material and financial support for the academic year 2024/2025
- Train and empower the underprivileged and unemployed women to support themselves and their families.

For this year our target is 22 female students 3 women

The Challenge

- There is a wide gender gap in education in Cameroon. Between the ages of 6 and 14 only 80% of girls attend school in comparison to 94% of boys.
- In Cameroon, the legal age to get married is 18 and 21 for boys.
- The crises in the North-West, South-West and Far-North regions have exacerbated all forms of gender-based violence (GBV), including forced marriages and sexual violence.
- The crises in Manyu Division has disrupted and forced many girls to drop-out of school.
- Many of them, orphans, and the underprivileged women have become vulnerable to physical and sexual gender-based violence (GBV).
- Poverty, lack of educational resources, demotivation and societal biases are some barriers that young girls in Manyu face in accessing education and employment.

Our Solution

Introducing our comprehensive back to school assistance program:

- Coaching and Mentorship Sessions
- Community Engagement
- School Supply Kits
- Tuition and Fees Assistance
- Sanitary Products




School Supply Kits

Each underprivileged girl child who has engaged her commitment will be provided with:

- A backpack,
- Relevant Books,
- School uniform,
- Sanitary product,
- School sandals,
- Stationeries.

This is to ensure that they have the basic materials needed to attend school regularly and carry out expected activities to enhance performance and economic sustainability.



Categories of Beneficiaries

Our expenditures per beneficiary will be based on the following categories:

- First cycle art
- First cycle science
- Second cycle art
- Second cycle science
- Undeprivileged /Unemployed Women



Coaching and Mentoring

- AUDAV shall engage experts and competent coaches and mentors to guide students in making their academic and career choices,
- Identify areas of challenges, identify and analyze strategies to overcome academic, emotional challenges.
- Motivational Talk sessions will be organized two times every semester.
- AUDAV will provide academic guidance and emotional support through qualified experts.
- Frequency will be determined by progress rate and need of the student.
- This will format girls' mindset, develop self-esteem and discovery of potentials for a transformative future



Dream Big, Hold Onto Your Dream, Serve

Tuition and Training Assistance for 2024/2025:

The project will cover school fees and other mandatory costs. These include:

- School tuition,
- Examination fees,
- Other mandatory costs
- Training cost

This will remove the financial barrier that often prevents families from sending their daughters to school and exposes the girl child to sexual marauders. Build and enhance skills



Community Engagement

- AUDAV shall partner with families, stakeholders and local community leaders to raise awareness about the importance of girls' sustainable and transformative education.
- Letters requesting for collaboration and partnership shall be addressed to families of beneficiaries and community leaders.
- AUDAV shall organize collective and individual interactive conversations/interviews with families of beneficiaries and community leaders in Mamfe.
